Just to follow up on our phone conversation today. Pittwater Council has prepared an REF for the use of Station Beach as an off-lead area for dogs and has sent it to Crown Lands (as the land owner) for comment. I have spoken to Stan Rees from Lands and he is looking for support from other affected agencies to prevent this off-lead trial going ahead. There are no real threatened species issues for EPRG. It seems that the major issues for DECC would relate to the management consequences for the adjoining Barrenjoey Headland and I understand that you will be preparing a submission to Council in relation to this. It would be useful to talk to Stan about a co-ordinated response back to Council from both Lands and DECC and potentially DPI if there are also likely to be management issues for the adjacent aquatic reserve. Stan can be contacted on 88 365 346. He can provide a copy of Council's REF.
